
How to setup DHCP on Windows 10



- 1. Click on Windows logotype Control Panel
- 2. Click on Network and Internet
- 3. Click on Network and Sharing Center
- 4. Click on Change adapter settings

4. Right click on **Local Area Connection** and choose **Properties.**



- 5. Highlight **Internet Protocol Version 4** and click on **Properties**.
- 6. Choose Obtain IP address automatically and
- 7. Choose Obtain DNS server automatically
- 8. Click OK.
